Bates Technical College (KBTC), is the licensee of noncommercial educational television stations KBTC-TV, Tacoma, WA, and KCKA, Centralia, WA.

KBTC is committed to building a diverse and inclusive workplace and strongly encourages members of traditionally underrepresented communities to apply for job openings. KBTC is dedicated to providing broad outreach regarding job listings at the station. KBTC recruits from a variety of sources, including Indeed.com and Governmentjobs.com. All job openings are also listed on both the station's website (kbtc.org) and the college's website (batestech.edu).

KBTC regularly provides training and mentoring professional development programs and seminars for employees to acquire skills and qualify for higher level positions. These opportunities include a wide variety of public media technical training programs.
